MAY 23 <> HOME TO FAIRBANKS <> Home Pick Up transfer to airport for your flight to Fairbanks. Alaska's "Golden Heart City" of Fairbanks is a great introduction to the heart of this unique state. Check in to the Fairbanks Princess Riverside Lodge and get ready for the beginning of your adventure. Meet your Tour Director and fellow traveling companions this evening.

MAY 24 <> FAIRBANKS TO DENALI <> A cruise along the Chena River on a Sternwheeler Riverboat is about as authentic as it gets. Later, you'll head for Denali National Park via a scenic motorcoach trip for your arrival at the first of your two destinations at Denali, the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge.

MAY 25 <> DENALI <> Explore Denali National Park on a Natural History Tour, watching for glimpses of Denali as well as Denali's "Big Five"; bears, moose, caribou, wolves and Dall sheep. Later today, you may want to simply relax overlooking the Nenana River. Visit the Grizzly Burger to indulge in the Ernesto Burger, or grab a slice at Lynx Creek Pizza.

MAY 26 <> DENALI TO MT. MCKINLEY <> This morning you'll travel by rail from Denali to Talkeetna for one night at the Mt. McKinley Princess Wilderness Lodge. Take in the sensational views of Denali and the Alaska Range with a glass of wine in the Great Room or on the deck. Hear stories about climbing Denali in the Hudson Theater or roast a marshmallow at the fireside patio.



MAY 27 <> MT. MCKINLEY TO ANCHORAGE <> You have morning to enjoy. Walk the nature trails around the lodge or sit and gaze at the majesty of "The Great One" from the lodge's treehouse. Then board your motorcoach for an enjoyable ride to Anchorage for the night.

MAY 28 <> ANCHORAGE TO WHITTIER <> After a morning enjoying the vistas, you'll journey to Whittier and board the *Majestic Princess*.

MAY 29 <> HUBBARD GLACIER SCENIC CRUISE <> The largest tidewater glacier in North America, Hubbard Glacier measures 76 miles long and plunges 1,200 feet into the depths of the bay. Its immense beauty and phenomenal blue hues are enchanting, even from afar. But it's when your cruise ship draws closer that its towering surface dwarfs even the uppermost deck on your ship at a whopping 40 stories high. You'll have a prime viewing spot from which to witness the glacier calving, as it often expels icebergs the size of 10-story buildings-imagine the splash! **(B, L, D)**

MAY 30 <> GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK SCENIC CRUISING <> Princess is one of a select few cruise lines permitted to cruise the pristine waters of Glacier Bay, the highlight of our 7-day Voyage of the Glaciers cruise. Just west of Juneau, this breathtaking national park and preserve boasts some of the world's most spectacular tidewater glaciers, such as Margerie Glacier, which often drops colossal chunks of ice into the sea. Not surprisingly, Glacier Bay National Park and its epic ice giants are part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site comprising Alaska's magnificent park system. **(B, L, D)**

MAY 31 <> SKAGWAY <> Skagway was the gateway to the gold fields for the thousands who flocked to Alaska and the Yukon with the hope of striking it rich. Skagway may have boasted the shortest route to the Klondike, but it wasn't the easiest. Over 100 years ago, the White Pass route through the Coast Mountains and the shorter but steeper Chilkoot Trail were used by countless stampedeers. Many a would-be miner perished on the treacherous Chilkoot Trail. **(B, L, D)**

JUNE 1 <> JUNEAU <> No roads lead to Juneau, which gives the Alaskan capital a misty inscrutability. You need to come by air or water, but when you arrive, the place will delight you with its bounty of water, forests, and mountains. Squeezed between the Gastineau Channel and Coast Mountains, Juneau offers a lot of variety in close proximity. The massive Mendenhall Glacier and the immense Juneau Icefields **(B, L, D)**



JUNE 2 <> KETCHIKAN <> Explore this uniquely Alaskan port, famous for its rich native culture, salmon fishing and scenic Misty Fjords. Ketchikan is a major commercial fishing port with several salmon canneries and processing plants. It is the salmon capitol of the world and also has the world's largest collection of totem poles. Today Creek Street is one of the more unique shopping areas of Alaska and an easy walk from the cruise ship dock. **(B, L, D)**

JUNE 3 <> DAY AT SEA <> Relax and enjoy a full day of scenic Inside Passage cruising and immerse yourself in Princess Cruise Line elegance. **(B, L, D)**
